The Children's Center is a non-profit agency providing mental health treatment to emotionally and behaviorally troubled preschool aged children and their families. We provide clinical therapeutic services, social skills groups for children on the autism spectrum, state-wide consultation and training on childhood trauma, and a therapeutic preschool that serves 200 children. Between our locations in Salt Lake and Kearns, we serve 2000 families from every zip code in Salt Lake County. Because of this, we have a very diverse "student body," and love having volunteers that speak multiple languages. We are able to provide a sliding scale to our clients, and don't turn anyone away on their inability to pay. 72% of our clients are at poverty level.
